**RE: Division 2 – Flight Simulators at Bankstown Airport**

This term we have been looking at the Principles of Flight, which goes towards attainment of the “Aviation” badge.

**Basair**, a flying school at Bankstown Airport has agreed to let us use their flight simulators to give the boys a better understanding of what flying an aircraft is about. This is not Microsoft Flight Simulator but is laid out like the actual cockpit of a twin-engine plane, with full instrumentation. The instructor controls the environment and can throw all sorts of emergency situations at the student. It should be an exciting evening.

They are also going to let the boys sit in a real aircraft. (Maybe we’ll get to fly on another occasion).

All boys are required to wear full SWAG uniform, although the SWAG cap may be used instead of the beret.
